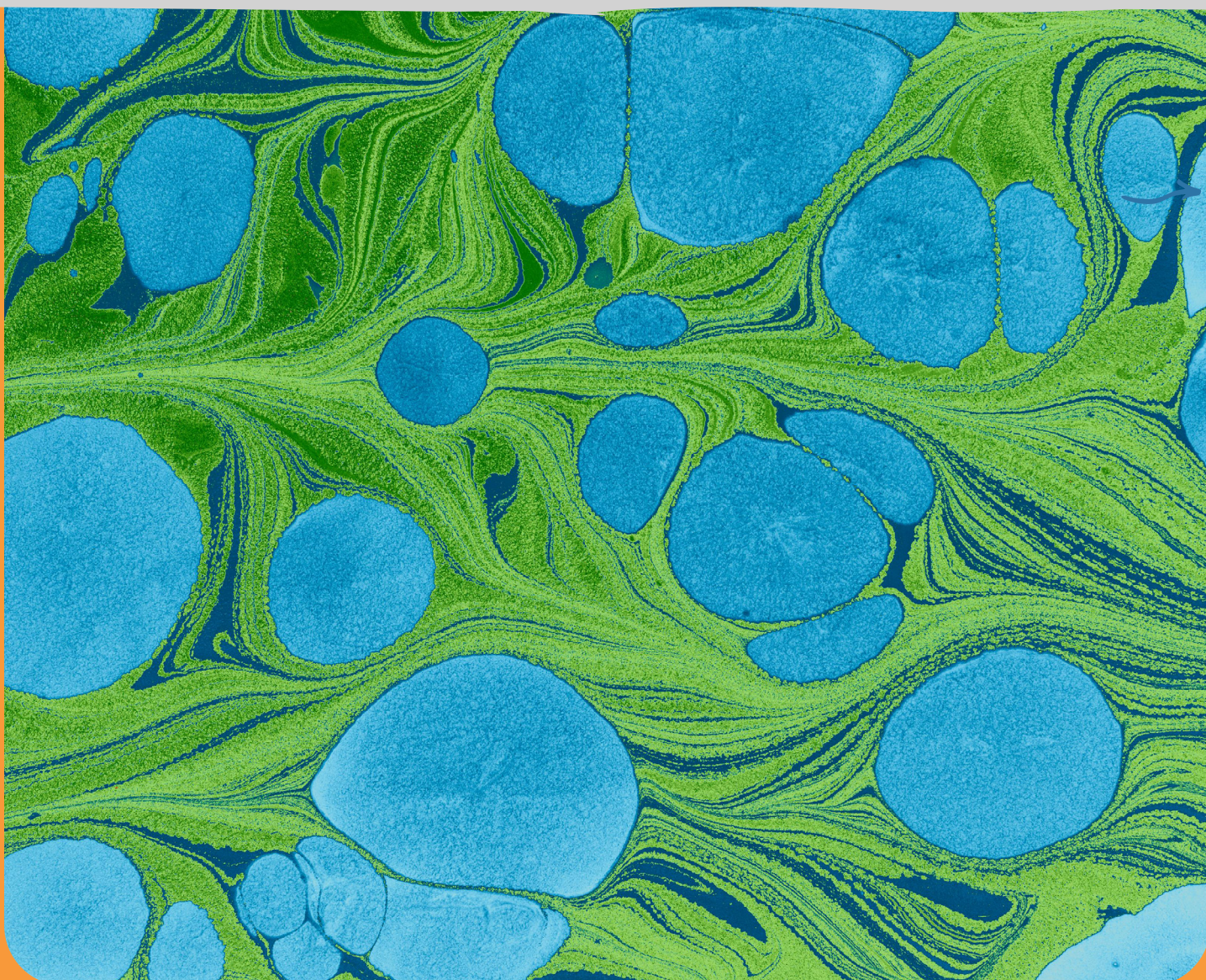

The Full Bake: Introduction to Sourdough

Saturday, January 24 | 12-3pm

This workshop takes you through every stage of sourdough baking in an interactive, beginner-friendly way. Fresh loaves will be available to show ideal results, along with loaves baked with intentional beginner mistakes so you can learn how to "read" crumb structures. Using ready to go dough, you'll learn stretch-and-folds, coil folds, shaping, and scoring. You will go home with your own starter, a care card, and a recipe so you can continue baking and experimenting at home.
