

Create a polymer clay doorway, which can be inserted into a real pumpkin and reused year after year.

Paint a whimsical ghost, along with a pumpkin and cat, on a pumpkin-shaped wood plaque.

Join Collaboratory staff at the **Fresh Meadow Nature Trail** for an outdoor drawing program! Participants will use oil pastels and/or charcoal to create nature drawings. One-on-one instruction and all drawing materials will be provided.

Sculpt a polymer clay pin celebrating everyone's favorite fungus.

Learn techniques to make cards that can be given for Thanksgiving, to say thank you, or to show gratitude. Each participant will stamp sayings, use embossing folders and die cuts, and do some ink-blending.

Paint a tumbler with glass paint for a stained glass effect! Trace a fall scene for this beautiful, functional project.

Craft a timeless centerpiece to brighten your home.

Note: This program requires finger dexterity to thread a needle, sew, and twist wire

Create a realistic life-sized polymer clay poinsettia flower just in time for your holiday giving or entertaining. Each participant will create one flower.

Create a mosaic using buttons. Trace a shape of your choosing and sew buttons onto your "canvas" for this personalized creation!

Create your very own Krampus from clay! Krampus is a European legend, a mythical creature that appears around the holidays.

Use die cuts, embossing folders, and stamps to make three beautiful holiday cards, including a 3D card. No card-making experience needed. All materials provided, including envelopes so they are ready to send to your loved ones.

Learn the laser cutting and etching process for wood veneers and then assemble a pre-cut Wallingford Public Library bookmark.

Paint a cheery winter-themed penguin family on a repurposed slate. This is an intermediate level painting project.

Resin Flower Coaster

This class will review all of the different digitization options available in the Collaboratory and how they operate.

This class will explain how to use Silhouette Studio, the software used to create custom designs for the Silhouette vinyl cutting machines.
