

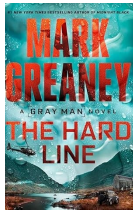

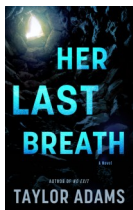

In the 20th Cotton Malone novel, the former Justice Department operative is summoned to Sweden when the king's younger sister is kidnapped.



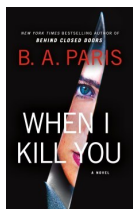

This sequel to the bestselling and Apple TV+ series *The Last Thing He Told Me* is set five years in the future.



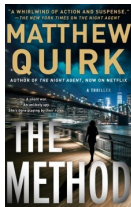
**THE STORM**

A gulf coast beach motel has survived a century of hurricanes but has also been the site of several mysterious deaths.



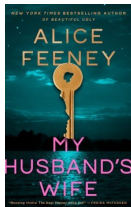
