




HOLLYWOOD HITS: A Movie Music Extravaganza!

Tuesday, July 15th | 7pm | Community Room & Zoom

Join us for a Hollywood movie music extravaganza! Musician **Ryan Mitten** will perform a wide variety of famous film tunes, from monster melodies to John Williams themes to iconic instrumentals like the theme from *The Godfather*. He will also invite the audience to sing along to Hans Zimmer hits and showtunes from *Wicked* and *The Sound of Music*. Skip the movie theater and come down for a one-of-a-kind musical experience at the library!

BASED ON A TRUE STORY: The Real-Life Cases Behind Hollywood Horror

Join us for an intriguing event featuring chilling stories from the real cases behind some of Hollywood's most famous horror films! **Joe Franke**, a seasoned local paranormal expert, worked closely with world-renowned psychic researchers Ed and Lorraine Warren for over four decades. Her expertise has been instrumental in bringing the vision of costume designers to life, ensuring that every garment enhances the storytelling magic of theater and film. An expert in fit, pattern, and process, Dr. Trautman has collaborated with award-winning costumers, contributing to the success of acclaimed productions including *The Greatest Showman* and *Bohemian Rhapsody*. Samples of costumes from *Bohemian Rhapsody*, *Bridgerton*, and other film & television wardrobes will be on display during the event. You may even try one on! This presentation promises to be as educational as it is entertaining, offering attendees a rare behind-the-scenes look at the intricacies of costuming.

FROM WIZARD TO WICKED: The Greatest Film Adaptations of All Time

From the beginning, books have been the inspiration for many films. Most were bestsellers, others were simply great books. But they were all adapted into famous films. This presentation by author and pop culture historian **Marty Gitlin** features video clips of the best of the best, including such unforgettable classics as *The Wizard of Oz, To Kill a Mockingbird, The Godfather, Jaws, One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*, and *The Shining*, as well as more modern standouts such as *Forrest Gump, Harry Potter*, and *Wicked*. 
